The WIAA Sectional Meet is being held at Pewaukee on Saturday, October 24th starting at 9:30 AM.
- The boys soccer team looks to finish up the year in the middle of the pack in the Woodland Conference. Pewaukee was awarded #3 seed and will be hosting East Troy on Tuesday, October 13th at 6:30 PM. Pewaukee will host the WIAA Sectional Final on Saturday, October 24th at 3:00 PM.
