

Pewaukee High School Booster Club Meeting Minutes – April 12, 2010

Meeting called to order at 7:08 pm.

Minutes of March 1, 2010 meeting were approved without amendment.

Treasurer's Report:

Patty Fleetwood reports that: BC has granted \$5,957 to our teams and clubs in the month of March, and \$52,655 YTD (in concessions and discretionary grants). We will be using a new form to track 50/50 Raffle information better. Motion made, seconded and approved to accept the Treasurer's report.

Athletic Director's Report:

John Maltsch reports that:

- Wrestling: Took 2nd place at the Team State meet, losing a tough battle to Oconto Falls.
- Girls Basketball: Congratulations on finishing the year as Woodland Conference Blue Division champions, and then Regional champions for the second year in a row. The girls finished 22-3 setting a school record for most wins in a season. Earning 1st Team All-Conference honors were senior Hannah Frett, and sophomores Jordyn Swan and Emily Wirth. 2nd Team honors went to senior Shannon Kalamarz, who also was named to the WBCA Division 2 South All-Star Team. Congratulations to Todd Hansen, who will be the Head Coach for the South Team.
- Boys Basketball: Congratulations on finishing with a 20-4 record, and becoming the first ever 3-peat conference champions in school history. Earning 1st Team All-Conference honors were seniors Mike Olewinski and Tyler Hanson. 2nd Team honors went to senior Matt Dabney. Mike Olewinski was also named to the WBCA Division 2 South All-Star Team.
- JV Cheer: Brought home a 1st place trophy from the Hype cheer championship, in the cheer and stunt division.
- Acadec: Placed 3rd in Division 2 at the State competition. They placed 8th overall in State, moving up 4 spots from their previous ranking. Monica He earned a state record by becoming only the 2nd person in the 27 year history of the Decathlon to earn a perfect score in the Super Quiz event.
- Varsity Math Team: Captured another Conference championship.
- Pirate Thespians: Recent performance "*You're a Good Man Charlie Brown*" was highly successful.

- Robotics: Will be headed to Atlanta later this week for National competition.
- Spring sports are underway, with the weather being highly cooperative for outdoor practices.
- 2 new Head Coaches this year: Girls Soccer – Rick Kocchi, and Softball – Jerry Alberti.
- Track has 2 new assistant coaches: Jim Ertel – pole vault, and alum Nick Magnus – High Jump and Sprints. The over 100 Track participants are showing a very strong work ethic. PHS will host the Alzheimer Invite on Friday, April 30th.
- Golf: Begins this week.

Committee Reports:

Concessions: John Knepprath reports that there are a few open soccer games for concessions. He will be seeking volunteers to fill the spots.

New Business:

FOFA: Requested the use of our charge account for accepting payments in the Pewaukee's Got Talent event and our Treasurer approved.

Returning Board Members & Committee Chairmen: We will begin to determine what positions will be available for next year. The new board will be voted in at our June meeting. Christine requested the Board members to give her names of parents to solicit volunteers for the open positions since we don't have a nominating committee.

Marketing to 8th Grade Families: We will be brainstorming for ideas to get Asa Clark families involved in BC.

WBCA All-Star Games: Coach Todd Hansen expressed thanks to BC for the new shooting gun. Coach Hansen will be coaching the Girls All-Star game this summer, Saturday June 19th. This is a great honor. The charitable purpose of the event is to raise money for the MACC Fund. Over \$125,000 was raised last year. Coach Hansen requested a BC donation towards his individual fund-raising efforts. A motion was made, seconded and approved to make a \$300 donation on behalf of Coach Hansen, and \$100 each on behalf of Shannon Kalamarz and Mike Olewinski (if in fact the students request a donation).
