- Girls' Soccer (7<sup>th</sup> ranked) played Catholic Memorial in the Sectionals 1<sup>st</sup> round.
- Lady Pirate Softball finished the season with a 11-14 record overall.
- Golf Team placed 5<sup>th</sup> in Conference. At Regionals, they just missed qualifying for state. Freshman, Corey Sweeney qualified for state as an individual.
- The baseball team beat Woodland South Division favorite Greendale and just finished a trip to the Metrodome in Minneapolis.
- Athletic Awards: Josh Mohr – Opie Award as Best Overall Athlete. Amy Slesar and Geordin Panagopoulos were the Most Valuable Senior Awards, Krystal Sterling and Ben Landry – Most Dedicated and Alex Albrecht received the Coach's Award.
