

2010 PHS Booster Club – Scholarship Selection

The Pewaukee High School Booster Club is not an academic organization and therefore does not offer a scholarship solely based on academic achievements.

The PHS Booster Club seeks to recognize and award students who have enriched their high school experience through extracurricular school activities while becoming active citizens in society through their community involvement, volunteering, or employment experiences.

Four \$500.⁰⁰ scholarships will be awarded based on the following scoring method:

Scholarship scoring overview

Step 1:

All applications evaluated to meet minimum requirements:

- 3.0 and higher cumulative GPA
- Completed application and transcript received by due date

Step 2:

All applications meeting minimum requirements are scored in Step 2

- 100 pt maximum - School related activities (GPA, Arts, Club, Sports, Leadership, Awards)
- 100 pt maximum - Outside school activities (Volunteer time, Community involvement, Work experience, Leadership, Awards)

Top 50% of high scores from Step 2 move to Step 3

Step 3:

- 70 pt maximum – Essay evaluation (Content, Communication, Grammar, Spelling)
- 30 pt maximum – Overall involvement and positive impact within the school and community

The 4 highest combined scores from Step 2 and Step 3 are selected to receive awards.

Decisions on these scholarships are based entirely upon the information submitted via the application process. All decisions are final.
